The American College

Facts & Figures of the American College

→ 141 student rooms and 17 studios : approx. 170 inhabitants

→ 3 communities live in this college:

- Saint Damien Community: American students Theology/Philosophy
- Mater Dei Community: international priests and laypeople (Theology/Philosophy/Canon Law)
- University Parish: Belgian students who actively participate in volunteer work or other ways of personal formation

→ The other (non-community) rooms are inhabited by students from all faculties, men and women, aged between 18 and 25.

→ Praesidium organized by the students: grand ball, movie nights, quiz, cantus, activities for a good cause, ...

→ Aulneroom (former refectory) to be used by the entire University and 2 Rectoral Salons to be used by the General Management of the University.

The Residence Manager is Rebekka Jonkers (Ma. Theology).
She is assisted by 4 house assistants (older students).

Content

4 important phases:

- **1840 until 1860:** *Spalding* notices that there is a great shortage of educated priests in the U.S.A. He takes the initiative to set up a Seminary in the Old Europe where missionaries are trained to be sent to America: the origin of the American College. P. Kindekens is to be the first Rector.
- **1860 until 1889:** *De Neve*, the 2nd Rector, takes it as his life's work to educate the priests to missionaries. The Louvain missionaries get a lot of support in the U.S.A.
- **1889 until 1949:** The American College during World War I and II. Mainly during the rectorship of De Becker.
- **1949 until 2016:** A new start for the American College. Visit of the Pope and Belgian King Boudewijn. In a later stage, there are renovations that result in the American College as we know it today.

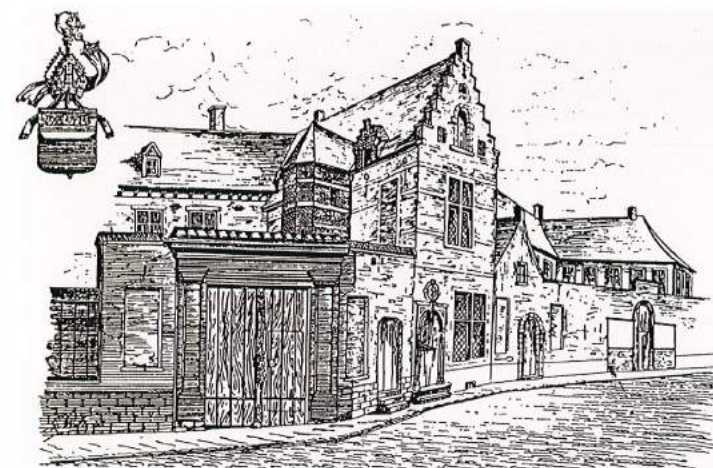
